

GREEN GOO RECIPE

A Goopy, Glittery Slime-Making Activity

Mix up your own batch of stretchy, glittery green goo using things from around the house. Gather your supplies, choose an activator, then follow the steps below — and don't skip the tips!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

☐ 1 cup white school glue (washable, non-toxic)



ACTIVATOR

1 bottle Elmer's Magical Liquid (slime activator)

☐ Food coloring (*optional*)

☐ Glitter (*optional*)

☐ Mixing bowl

☐ Spoon or spatula

TIPS

- ✓ Always supervise young children
- ✓ Wash hands before and after playing
- ✓ Store in an airtight container when not in use
- ✓ If too sticky, add a little more activator
- ✓ If too stiff, add a small amount of glue
- ✓ Elmer's Magical Liquid is specially made for green goo and is a great worry-free option!

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Pour 1 cup of white school glue into your mixing bowl.
- 2 If you want colored green goo, add 2-3 drops of food coloring now and mix.
- 3 Add your activator:
Add 2-3 tablespoons of Elmer's Magical Liquid and stir quickly.
- 4 Keep stirring until the green goo pulls away from the bowl. If it's too sticky, add a tiny bit more activator (½ tablespoon at a time).
- 5 Knead the green goo with your hands for 2-3 minutes until it's smooth and stretchy.

PLAY TIME!

Your green goo is ready! Stretch it, squish it, and have fun. It should last 1-2 weeks in a sealed container.



SAFETY FIRST

While this recipe uses common household items, adult supervision is recommended, and green goo should not be eaten.
